GREENFIELD PARK MACKAY CENTER SOFTBALL TOURNAMENT

The Greenfield Park/MacKay Centre Softball Association is planning its twelfth annual Greenfield Park Charity Softball Tournament for the Mackay Centre to be held on August 15-16-17-18, at the Pierre Laporte Park. Come and enjoy some good softball for a great cause.

The Association was founded by friends of Michael Reid who died in 1984 from muscular dystrophy. Since the start of the event in August 1985, when they raised \$5,600, to last year when \$18,622 was raised, a grand total of over \$144,622 has been sent to the Mackay Centre. These funds are utilized by the deaf and physically disabled children for outings, trips and extracurricular activities. The Association has a



committee of 8 people and 60 volunteers, most of them coming from the Greenfield Park Legion and the Town. Last year 32 teams participated in the tournament and we expect just as good a turnout this year. The umpires are volunteers drawn from the teams involved. Everyone working on the tournament is a volunteer and there are no monetary prizes.

This year the Town will be providing a bursary to the Association to be used in the sponsorship of a child from the Mackay Centre.

Good luck to all and let's hope this year's tournament will be even more successful than in the past.
